
Carnival T-Shirts. Thanks to all who participated in the annual carnival t-shirt contest! There were many amazing entries.

Update to MES PTA Bylaws

The Virginia PTA requires local unit PTAs to revise their bylaws and submit them for state approval every 5 years. The deadline for the Matoaka Elementary School PTA's revision is June 20, 2017.

The MES PTA Bylaws Committee has prepared a revised set of bylaws and must now submit these to the general membership for review and comment.

The general membership must have 30 days to review the bylaws, and the bylaws must be put to a vote of the general membership.

The bylaws will be up for a vote at the general membership meeting on April 19, 2017. The proposed bylaws must be approved by a two-thirds affirmative vote at the meeting.

The proposed bylaws (red-lined version) is on the Matoaka PTA website and a copy is in the front office at school for your review.
